Garnock Active Travel Study: Get feedback and input into the initial shortlisted active travel routes/measures for potential upgrade/implementation within the towns of Beith, Kilbirnie and Dalry.

Lochshore Active Travel Routes: Get feedback on the preliminary active travel paths proposed as part of the redevelopment of Lochshore.
