


# Ayrshire Community Justice Partnership Supported and Validated Self-Evaluation - Communication Brief

After a period of scheduled activities between December 2018 and March 2019, the Care Inspectorate have now published their validation letter.

A number of areas of good practice have been highlighted and recognition has been paid to the strengths of the partnership in building on the structures and relationships established under the previous arrangements.

Where areas of further improvement were highlighted, the Care Inspectorate feel confident that the partnership is well placed to establish a shared culture of continuous improvement and continue to strive to achieve excellence in the implementation and delivery of the community justice model.

We will take the learning identified from the self-evaluation process and use this to develop an improvement plan. This will take the partnership forward to the next stage of being able to identify what difference our work is making to the lives of individuals and for communities.

We will also work towards including all statutory partners in future self-evaluation in order to bring additional value to the process.
