1.	Welcome and Apologies The Chair welcomed everyone to the meeting and apologies were noted.

3.	<p>Police Report</p> <p>Sgt Joe Murdoch advised that in the period 17th February to 17th March, there had been 127 calls to the police and 27 crime reports had been raised. This was down from 178 calls last month and 178 in the same period last year. Of the four North Ayrshire policing priorities:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Drug Dealing and Misuse – 1 call 2. Violence and Anti-Social Behaviour – 30 calls 3. Dishonesty and Theft – 10 calls 4. Road Safety / Road Crime – 11 calls <p>During this period, there were 46 priority 1 and 2 calls. There were 6 missing person calls and 6 calls with concerns for persons. Of the 27 crime reports, there were 11 thefts with 1 detected, 3 drugs with 2 detected, 4 breach of the peace with 1 detected and 2 assaults with 1 detected.</p>
