Three Towns Swimming Pool Frequently Asked Questions

• Would I be able to get a bus or train to the new pool?

The Stagecoach Number 11 service (Kilmarnock-Ardrossan) and the 585 service (Ayr-Greenock) both pass close to the proposed site (approx. 200m). A new train and bus hub is planned for the harbour area as part of the wider improvement of the town.

- Will the pool at Harvies be demolished? If the proposal goes ahead the Council will work with the local community to consider the future of the building.
- Would it not be better to refurbish Harvies? Harvies is over 45 years old and the Council does not currently have the funding to refurbish it to meet the public's expectations.
- Will the ice rink and the fitness suite at Harvies end up closing because of this? The ice rink and fitness suite are located within the newer part of Harvies and there are no plans to relocate or close these facilities.
- Will the new Additional Support Needs school pupils need to use the pool at Harvies? The new ASN school will have its own small, dedicated pool and hydrotherapy facility.

• If the new pool is in the Ardrossan Campus, will the public only be able to use it at evenings and weekends?

It is anticipated that the pool facility will operate on the same basis as the current Auchenharvie Pool and will be open to the public throughout the day.

- Will the public have to walk through the new school to get to the swimming pool? One of the key design considerations will be to ensure that there is separate public access to the pool.
- Aren't people from Stevenston missing out if you move the pool?
 The Council's swimming facilities are for use by people from across the whole of North Ayrshire.
- Why is Stevenston missing out on investment? There has been significant investment in Stevenston in recent years e.g. the Library and Employability Hub, new town centre improvements, school improvements and new housing.
- **Doesn't Ardrossan need better leisure facilities?** The proposed Ardrossan Campus is part of a large scale development which includes proposals for the pool and sports facilities.
