4.	<p>Police Report</p> <p>Sgt Joe Murdoch put in apologies but submitted a report by email that was read out. He advised that in the period 9th November to 9th December, there had been 154 calls to the police and 34 crime reports had been raised. There were 189 calls last month and 189 in the same period last year.
