Larders are being set up across North Ayrshire with the support of North Ayrshire Council. The aim is simple. Larders are there to assist households to access good, healthy and nutritional food.

## There are only two criteria.



Is your household income low?  
Can the Larder help you to source a healthy supply of food?



## How does it work?



This is a membership service and has a weekly fee of £4.00.

In return members are entitled to 1 weekly shop.



The food selected is worth between £16.00 – £20.00

## How do you join?



Complete an application form  
Bring your proof of residency for an address below the High Road.  
Bring both along on your first visit.



## When is the Larder open?

Friday: 4.00pm until 8.00pm  
Saturday: 10.00am until 2.00pm

Membership is open to all North Ayrshire Residents until Larders open within their communities. Those who live above the High Road are encouraged to join the Larder based at the Whittees Community Centre. The food selected is to assist to reduce the spend of a household on food. It is not the provision of a weekly shop. You will still need to go to the supermarket for additional food items. What is available may change from week to week. If you are unsure as to what is on offer feel free to drop into the larder to have a look and discuss with the larder volunteers.
