# WORRYING ABOUT MONEY? HELP IN NORTH AYRSHIRE



### I suddenly have no money

Maximise your income by getting a benefit check from Money Matters.

If you are a Council or housing association tenant you can also contact your housing provider.

Ask for a crisis grant from North Ayrshire Council.

Ask for a hardship payment from the Jobcentre if you have a benefit sanction.

Challenge a benefit decision if your benefit has been refused/stopped/reduced/sanctioned with help from Money Matters.



# I have debts that I am having problems paying

Get debt advice by contacting CHAP. If you are a Council or housing association tenant you can also contact the Welfare Reform Team or Financial Inclusion Officer. If you live in the Three Towns or Arran use the Better Off North Ayrshire service.

### My money doesn't stretch far enough

Maximise your income by contacting Money Matters and getting a benefits check. If you have made a new claim for benefit you can ask for an advance payment from the Jobcentre. Community Link Workers can support with budgeting advice. Citrus Energy can help with utility costs.
