Local communities in Largs, Saltcoats and Kilwinning are being invited to have their say and help shape the future of their town. As part of a pilot project North Ayrshire Council have selected Largs, Saltcoats and Kilwinning for the preparation of a Place Framework for each town to identify priorities and projects to address local needs and ambitions.

You are invited to participate in forthcoming activities to help prepare a Place Framework for each town; Largs, Saltcoats and Kilwinning.

Please share this invitation and information pack with anyone you believe has something to contribute to this project with their ideas for the future. We want to hear from as many different perspectives as possible; young and older, residents and visitors, businesses and customers, individuals and groups, local and national agencies and funders. Please have your say on the future of your Town.

A project team, led by Austin-Smith:Lord with WAVEparticle, have been appointed to work with local people to develop projects and ideas with a focus on delivery and future funding opportunities. Residents, business and anyone with an interest in each place is invited to public design and ideas workshops to propose ideas and projects to make each town even better in future.

The discussions in Saltcoats and Kilwinning will build on the outcomes of the design charrettes held in these towns in recent years.



Public Ideas Workshops will be held in each Town, alongside on-street engagement activities in advance and on the days of the Workshops. Events prior to the Workshops will include schools workshops and meeting people in and around each town as part of a 'Day in the Life Of...' each place.
